Congress of Vienna

**** Goal of the meeting =** Establish a *balance of power* in Europe after the defeat of Napoleon

- 5 Powers meet in Austria (Prussia [Germany], Russia, Austria, Britain and France)

- They met to create a Peace Treaty that will stabilize Europe



**** Klemens von Metternich =**

Most influential/powerful person at the meeting

- Hated the idea of Democracy (look at what it led to)
- Favored Monarchy as the best form of Government

Metternich's 3 Goals for the Congress of Vienna

- 1) Prevent future French aggression
- 2) Create a Balance of Power in Europe amongst Nations
- 3) Restore Europe's Royal Families to power

Goal #1: Prevent Future French Aggression

Solution: The European countries surrounded France with stronger nations

- By surrounding France with stronger countries ... it would be more difficult for France to expand its boundaries

Goal #2: Establish a Balance of Power in Europe

Solution:

- France was required to give up all the territory they gained under Napoleon's rule
- France was returned to its original boundaries
- No one (major) European nation could easily take over another



Napoleon's Empire. By 1812, Napoleon directly ruled or controlled most of Europe.

Goal #3: Return the Royal Families of Europe to power

Solution:

Legitimacy = Metternich's idea to return the former rulers who were removed by Napoleon, back to power

France -- Louis XVIII returned to throne (replaced Napoleon)

Italy -- Ferdinand IV returned to throne (replaced Napoleon's brother-in-law Joachim Murat)

** By returning the royal families (Monarchies), this would stabilize the politics of Europe (prevent future wars)

Legacy of the Congress of Vienna

** The Congress of Vienna was one of the most successful peace treaties ever created

1815 = Congress of Vienna; Peace treaty signed

1914 = WWI; first war between European powers after the Congress of Vienna

Concert of Europe =

-- Agreement between many European nations to help each other if a democratic revolution broke out in one of their countries
