





Battle of the Marne River September 1914 - Fought 60 miles outside of Paris - French forces stopped German advance, forced them to retreat - Ended Germany's "Schlieffen Plan" - By 1915 the war in the Western Front becomes a standstill or "stalemate" Stalemate - neither side can advance or win - Both sides "dug in" and created a series of opposing trenches which will last throughout the rest of WWI
